- Thrift Store (Liz Pedraza & Jessi Merritt): Dates through November set. One of the biggest fundraisers. Supervisors needed (1–2 hr training). Can host more sales with more supervisors. Volunteers (age 10+) welcome. Encouraging class reps to organize 2 nights per class per year.
- Spirit Wear (Kyle Warren): Strong sales; Spirit Wear Day every Friday.
- Communications (Katie Smith): Will use Remind app and WIX email (with analytics and subscription).
- Student Council (Jennifer Abbott): Planning elections; will share expectations (time commitments, etc.). Volunteers needed to assist students.
