

CHATHAM COUNTY SCHOOLS - ESS

Chatham County Schools have a partnership with ESS. This has proven to be an effective means for temporarily filling a large number of our Instructional Assistant vacancies, particularly at Chatham Grove Elementary. At some schools the temporary position fill-rate is now 98% or higher by using short-term and/or long-term staff through ESS.

This is an opportunity for those interested in filling Instructional Assistant roles at CGE! AND Instructional Assistant substitutes with ESS are <u>not required</u> to complete the bus driver training course, which introduces a flexibility that many newer applicants desire.

ESS operates as an independent contractor and the direct application for the company can be accessed using the <u>linked shared here</u>.
